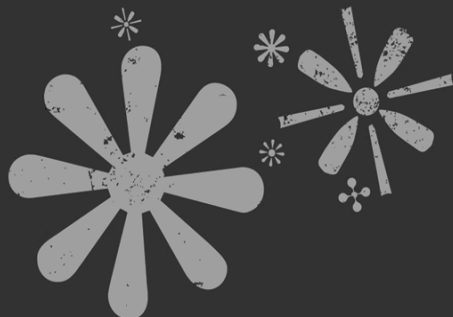

Tell-All Records is a small record label based in San Francisco. Our motivation is to release important, careful, ecstatic, moody, reckless sound.

*Tell-All Records, Vol. 1* presents a sampling of our aesthetic, with sounds ranging from Liam Singer's delicate vocals and piano on *The Last* to the hiss and noise of *yesvesd* from One Umbrella to Keith Negley's *Fall*, a “stunning, tender folk-song for the future.” (*erasing clouds*)

**Liam Singer** provides two tracks from his debut full-length on Tell-All, *The Empty Heart of the Chameleon*, which has garnered warm reviews and praise from critics and college radio alike.

**One Umbrella** offers two pieces, the piano-based *vnsire* and the 15-minute composition *yesvesd*. Based out of Austin, TX, the duo showcased at this year's **SXSW festival**. The *Solve* EP, their first release for Tell-All and a collection of new music with previous self-released material, was released in March and has received positive reviews.

**Golden Birds'** straightforward arrangements belie the complexity of their lyrics. Paranoid Records (France) recently released an extended version of their EP *Heart and Arms* in time for a European tour this past spring, and Webster McBride, the lead singer of the band, is following up that tour with a solo “50 state capitals” tour this summer.

**The Kallikak Family's** *May 23<sup>rd</sup> 2007* is Tell-All's latest release, coming to radio in July and record stores in August. Kallikak's previous work on States' Rights and On Purpose Records combined with extensive touring has earned them a devoted following across the country. Their new material ranges from simple, classical guitar compositions, to processed field recordings, to amalgams of seemingly familiar sounds placed in entirely new contexts. These otherwise disparate elements are sewn together to form a uniquely experiential masterpiece.

The compilation also features tracks by Bay Area solo artists **Peter Surla**, **St. Rosa**, and **Dave Zohrob**, as well as Boston band **28 degrees Taurus**. For more information, please visit [tellallrecords.com](http://tellallrecords.com).
